



## Privacy Notice for Customers and Business Partners

The General Data Protection Regulation or GDPR is a comprehensive set of data protection rules in the EU. It aims to protect to the greatest extent possible the rights of EU citizens against unauthorised handling of their data and personal details, and give them more control over what happens to their data. GDPR will affect everyone who collects and/or processes personal data. It comes into effect throughout the EU on 25 May 2018. In the Czech Republic, it supersedes the current data protection legislation constituted by Act No. 101/2000 Coll., on Personal Data Protection.

AERO Sped s.r.o. ("Company") processes personal data in compliance with the GDPR. All personal data processing is carried out only for the original intended purpose and on a relevant legal basis. The Company follows the basic principles such as lawfulness, fairness, transparency, purpose limitation, data minimisation, accuracy, storage limitations, integrity, confidentiality, and responsibility of the controller. The personal data processing rules are defined in the Company's internal regulations.

Every citizen (so-called data subject) has the right of access to personal data that concern him/her – the right to request information regarding whether and to what extent his/her personal data are processed by the Company. The Company provides the data subject with copies of the personal data processing.

In addition, every data subject has the right of erasure of data that the data subject provided to the Company on the basis of his/her consent to the processing of personal data, the right of rectification of his/her personal data processed, the right of objection, i.e. limitation on processing of the data that the data subject provided to the Company on the basis of his/her consent to the processing of personal data. All the above rights are exercised in the form of a written request of the data subject and based on the verification of the identification details provided to prevent the disclosure of data belonging to other persons. The above request may be submitted at the Company's site at Huštěnovice 266, 687 03.

If the data subject has a suspicion that his/her personal data are not handled in accordance with applicable legislation, he/she is entitled to notify the Company's representative thereof at the above address. If the situation is not remedied, the data subject is entitled to file a complaint to the supervisory authority, i.e. the Office for Personal Data Protection.
